

PRO COMP ELIMINATOR

New for 2018, we will offer an exciting new eliminator at the Project Filter Oldies But Goodies Drags. The class will be known as Pro Comp, resurrecting a name from yesteryear with an exciting, new twist.

Inspired by the open-wheel fraternity, Pro Comp will be to compete on the .4-tenths pro tree with a handicapped start.

QUALIFYING

This event will be run on the .400 Pro-tree (10.99 or quicker) during qualifying and eliminations (shallow or deep staging permitted, AutoStart will be activated).

ELIMINATIONS

Following all your Pro Comp qualifying runs, your dial in for eliminations will be one-tenth (.100) quicker than your quickest run during qualifying. So if you run 8.45 in qualifying, then you'll maintain a fixed dial in of 8.35 for the duration of eliminations. Or let's say you run a best of 9.85, then your fixed dial in will be 9.75. No changes to dial-in are permitted in elims.

TO RUN PRO COMP

The class permits transbrakes, line locks, automated shifters (no delay boxes or throttle-stops). All NHRA safety specs and licensing (9.99 or quicker) are required like any race staged at Firebird.

NOT PERMITTED

Pro Comp does not permit door cars, rear-engined dragsters or full fendered rides in this class. TruStart will not be offered in Pro Comp. Other than that—GOOD LUCK trying to win the first Pro Comp eliminator crown!!!
