EVENT INFORMATION

PARKING

- All coned off & paved spots are reserved and pre-assigned. Ask before parking.
- In order to keep roadways open, please park with the back or your trailer approximately 10 ft away from the road.

TECH

- Your Race Tech Card must be completed online through the NHRA website link.
- You must purchase your race/crew entry online on the FOAT.com (Woodburn Dragstrip).

TEST & TUNE

- Test & Tune entry and Tech card must be purchased & completed online through the FOAT.com (Woodburn Dragstrip)
- Testing runs 10 am-5 pm on Thursday. Cost: \$60
- LANE ASSIGNMENTS: Lane 1: EV. Lane 2, 3, 4, 5: Super Pro (1/8 mile). Lane 6, 7, 8, 9, 10: Full Tree .500.
- Lane 12: Jr Street (1/8 mile) East Lanes: ET Motorcycle. East Lanes (will follow Motorcycle): Jr Thunder & Jr Lightning.

RESTRICTED AREA

- You will be issued an Event Entry Wristband which must be worn throughout the event. This band allows you to go to town and entry back into the facility.
- For any **Restricted Area Access**: it is Mandatory that you sign the RELEASE AND WAIVER form which is located in the PRO/SOUVENIR SHOP which is behind the eastside grandstands (left lane side of track).
- You must have your Event Entry Wristband on your wrist in order to sign for the Restricted Area wristband.
- **MUST BE 16 years old and older to be in Restricted Areas.** It is Mandatory that BOTH parents or the minor child's legal guardians must sign the RELEASE and WAIVER form in the Tower for any minor of age 16 & 17.

BASIC RULES & INFORMATION

- NO engine noise prior to 8 am OR 30 minutes after the last car goes down track on any day.
- OIL DUMP TANK is located next to the Sunoco Race Fuel shed. DO NOT put oil in any other containers for disposal.
- **SUNOCO RACE FUELS** fuel shed is open Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday from 8 am 12 Noon.
- Woodburn Dragstrip is an OLCC facility. It is a violation of state law to consume alcoholic beverages not purchased at the Woodburn's Jimmy's Wheelie Bar. There is No outside Alcohol allowed and No Glass Bottles.
- <u>No Persons under the age of 16 may operate anything with wheels</u>. This includes but is not limited to: Quads/ATVs, Golf carts, Motorcycles, Skateboards, Bikes, and Rollerblades, etc. Operating any vehicles with wheels without a valid driver's license may result in loss of driving privileges at this event.
- SECURITY will be at the gate Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings.
- Please pick up after your pets. Pets must be on a 6 foot leash or less.
- Please be respectful of our neighbors and yours. No loud music after 10 pm any night. No generators from 10 pm-7 am.
- Please clean up after yourself. Bagged trash can be left next to the road for pickup after 5 pm each day.
- Please follow the directional arrows in the pits.
- Trip Zip Café is open serving breakfast for 7:00 am 10:30 am with lunch items served throughout the day.
- Trip Zip Café has Dinner Specials every night.
- If you leave the track and plan to return the same day, you Must have your Daily Event Entry Wristband on.
- RFC Chapel Service is at 7:45 am Sunday live on Facebook with RFC Chaplains.
- WiFi Hot Spot Connect to Public WiFi signal on your phone/laptop.

PAYOUTS

- Payout are available in the tower the day after the event.
- We require a W-9 (or W8BEN Canadians) for all amounts \$600 & over. Please complete, return in your form to the tower.
