MINIMUM SAFETY REQUIREMENTS for participating With a MOTORCYCLE at Firebird

OPEN TO STREET BIKE GRUDGE:

FINALE - OCT. 12 (GRUDGE)

Protective Clothing/Helmet (if you run UP TO 120 MPH):

- Full-face helmet with a Snell 2015 or 2020 tag/decal (typically located under inside padding)
- Long pants only. NO SHORTS
- Leather jacket.
- Leather boots/shoes above the ankle.
- Gloves must be Kevlar-lined and/or equipped with slide buttons.

Clothing (if you run OVER 120 MPH):

- Full-face helmet with a Snell 2015 or 2020 tag/decal (typically located under inside padding)
- Full all-leathers in one-piece or two-piece that joins together with a metal 360-degree zipper at the waist.
- Leather boots/shoes above the ankle.
- Gloves must be Kevlar-lined and/or equipped with slide buttons.

Safety requirements (from 2024 NHRA rule book):

- Current State Driver's License (non-restricted).
- All motorcycle riders must wear a full-face helmet, with a tag identifying a Snell 2015 or 2020 tag/decal. Snell tags or decals are often found located inside the helmet under the padding (stuck to Styrofoam).
- Tires must be in good condition with at least 1/16 inch tread and no cord showing. All lug nuts and bolts must be properly used and tight. Chain guards (per NHRA rule) - required.
- Motorcycles 9.99 seconds or quicker must be equipped with a positive ignition cutoff switch to the rider with a lanyard. OEM cutoff permitted in place of lanyard.
- No consumption of alcoholic beverages during the period of time you are running your vehicle.

Any motorcycles that run 9.99 or quicker in the quarter-mile is required to have current NHRA membership and NHRA license. Can-Am Spyder three wheelers are permitted.
