If you are a US citizen, you must carry proof of citizenship such as a:

- passport
- birth certificate
- certificate of citizenship or naturalization
- certificate of Indian status along with photo identification

Restricted and prohibited goods:

You may not be allowed to bring certain goods into Canada. Prohibited goods include:

cannabis

food, plants, animals and related products that pose a risk to Canada
endangered species and anything made from the parts or endangered
species (these can be found in some souvenirs)

You may need a permit or written authorization to bring other goods into
Canada, including

health products and prescription drugs

antiques or cultural objects that have historical significance to their country
of origin

explosives, fireworks and certain types of ammunition

All weapons and firearms must be declared when you enter Canada.

SPEED LIMITS

All race vehicles & support vehicles must observe 20 km (10 mph) speed limit in the pits and staging areas. Excessive speed in pits and return roads will be dealt with severely.

ONE WAY STREETS

All roads in the pits are one-way roads, running from west to east (or end of the track to the staging lanes). There are two exceptions to this, the road that runs along the river, as well as the main road that runs between the pit sections (south to north).



RADIO STATION - 92.7 FM

RESTRICTED AREAS – All persons entering the restricted areas must sign the waiver and release prior to entering. Restricted area wristband must be worn on the wrist in plain view. You must leave the restricted area immediately after your car has run down the track. Includes in front of the timing tower and the entire area behind the burnout boxes.

SCOOTERS, BIKES & GOLF CARTS



Anyone driving/riding on a pit bike of any kind (scooter, quad, motorcycle, bike, etc) is **REQUIRED to wear a helmet** at all times while on property. Bicycle helmets are permitted. Failure to comply will result in confiscation of your pit vehicle for the weekend and can result in disqualification from racing.

No one under the age of 16 is permitted to operate anything on wheels, this includes but is not limited to; golf carts, electric and non-electric scooters, electric and non-electric bikes, skateboards, etc. at any time while on property.

Junior Street Racers are not permitted to drive their cars back to their pit spot regardless of their age and/or BCDL status. They must pull over after exiting the racetrack as soon as it is safe and change seats with their adult copilot. It is preferred that you change seats prior to the treeline along the river.

Junior Dragster Racers are not permitted to drive their race cars within the pit area, race cars must be towed or pushed up to the staging lanes and must wait off the racetrack for their adults to meet them with their tow vehicle to return to their pit.

DRIVERS - A licensed driver must be in the car at all times when it is running. When running in gear, the rear axle must be on jack stands (as per NHRA rule book) and have a licensed driver in the car.

No burnouts, spinning or torqueing in the pit area, staging lanes, or camping areas. ANY infraction is grounds for disqualification.

No riding on cars.
